Dear Kaleidescape Customer,


Kaleidescape strives to improve the user experience with automatic software updates. With our latest update being deployed to all players and servers over the past month, we are introducing a new remote control for Strato players, and we have made updates to improve overall performance, including system and personal collection behavior.



New Remote Control for Strato Players

A new remote control has been chosen to replace the previous white remote control for Strato players. The new remote control is intuitive and features a streamlined set of buttons. In this kOS release, we have added support for new commands including: Search, Back, Play/Pause Toggle, and Closed Captions. There is no


number pad on the remote, so some interfaces on the OSD that require number entry have been modified to use an onscreen number entry. The remote control will be included with new Strato players and is now available for purchase as an add-on.



Performance Improvements and Fixes

We have made several behind-the-scenes improvements to enhance the playback experience, including:

- Refined management of the “New/Played” collections
 - You can now easily move a title back and forth between the “New” and “Played” collections
 - “Add to Collection” has been updated to separate Personal and System collections
 - “Played” collection has been added to the System collections group
 - “Create a Collection” has been moved to the bottom of the Personal collections list
- Bug fixes
